UPDATES 1. HOSTELS



- Complaints about bed bugs are always attended.
- Water testing of all 40 water testing points is done every month.
- Ground floor water testing is done every month.
- Water coolers and water dispensers are cleaned every weekend.
- Registered complaints are always attended and actions are taken as soon as possible
- Sanitary napkin bins are replaced in every 15 days.
- Fogging is done once in every week.
- Parcels are collected every 7 days a week.
- Microwave and hot plate are cleaned everyday.
- Dustbins and rooms are cleaned every alternate days.
- Monthly safety drills are also conducted.
 - Refrigerators are cleaned every weekends.
 - Elevators are cleaned every week and servising is done every month.
 - Study rooms are cleaned everyday.
 - Alpha and Franc are taken care of and their pool is cleaned every weekend.
- Ev vehicle board has been installed.
- Fire drills are conducted often.
- Issue regarding the kittens has been resolved.
- Water supply problems are always attended and resolved.
- Physical inspection of all tanks (overhead & underground) are done on regular basis.
- Issues regarding the hostels are frequently discussed with the wardens and resolved.

2. MESS

- New dry waste bins were installed in the mess.

- The wastebins in the mess are cleaned twice a week and are monitored by the team.
- New water taps have been installed in the hand washing area to avoid water leakage.
- Broken seats in the mess are being repaired, and all the seats will soon be functional.
